Introductions and Opening Comments - Charlie Gabriel

Set Scheduling

We are on track. Benchmarking/testing discussion will take place in January with Aaron Boone, Chick Langone, Charlie Gabriel, etc. Ray Herrick asked if the Team Leads are involved in the testing process. Charlie said yes the Team Leads would be involved.

Charlie Gabriel said we want to protect the warranty of the radios. Once you start the use of the radios, the warranty begins. We can test without the warranty overlapping.

Agency portable and mobiles

Review of the order for portable leather cases, the correct speaker mics etc were discussed. There are different lengths on the portable radio cords with mics, 12", 18" and 24". You can have an order of different lengths and try them out. SPD said they ordered 18" cords, as 24" was too long. After discussion, it was decided to order 18". The belt loops are 2.5" for the swivel belt T-strap (NMT146). There is a 3" stubby antenna on the mic and 6" antenna on the radios. Fire has the coil cord with the speaker mics and law enforcement have the straight cords with speaker mics.

Rick Rioux would like to sit down with Motorola to verify costs of the 2500 order for five dash mounts. Maybe update the Website with more defined information on what actually needs to be ordered would also be a help.

Captain Bleyle asked about the batteries on the portables. Motorola said they are 'Impress'. There is one individual charger for each radio, which is an Impress charger.

Tony DiGregorio would like a copy of what to order for EMS in detail.

Ray Herrick asked for a detailed copy also of what needs to be ordered.
